GCSO LAW ENFORCEMENT SUMMARY

DECEMBER 19, 2016 – DECEMBER 25, 2016

On Monday, December 19, Deputy A. White and Deputy D. Sanders responded to the 800 block of Brian Setterich Road to assist the Department of Children & Families (DCF) Victoria F. Turner (23) interfered with DCF while in the performance of their lawful duties. Deputy White attempted to restrain Turner after she became aggressive towards the investigator. Turner physically resisted Deputy White and she was placed under arrest for Obstruction – Resisting a Law Enforcement Officer without Violence. She was transported to the Gulf County Detention Facility (GCDF).

On December 19, a theft complaint was reported to Investigator L. Dickey at the GCSO Criminal Investigation Division. The complainant reported a chainsaw had been stolen out of the back of their truck in the White City area. Investigator Dickey continues to investigate.

On Tuesday, December 20, Deputy C. Smith extradited Indio L. Roldan (35) from the Bay County Jail. Gulf County held an active warrant for Violation of Probation, on his original charge of Possession of a Controlled Substance. He was transported to the GCDF.

On December 20, Deputy A. White executed two arrest warrants for Failure to Appear on Santana L. Pilotti (24). Pilotti failed to appear on her original charges of Driving While License Suspended/Revoked (DWLS/R) and No Vehicle Registration. She was transported to the GCDF by the Calhoun County Sheriff's Office after her arrest in Calhoun County.

On December 20, the GCSO received a 911 call regarding a residential burglary in the 1200 block of West River Road in Wewahitchka. When deputies arrived on scene it was determined the suspect had fled on foot. Deputies immediately developed Deonray Fisher (38) as the suspect. An investigation revealed once entry was made into the residence a purse was taken from the resident that contained cash and personal identification information. The resident was pushed to the floor as she attempted to retrieve the purse. Fisher was arrested by Investigator L. Dickey on Thursday, December

22, and charged with Home Invasion Robbery, Battery on a Person Over 65, and Grand Theft. He was transported to the GCDF.

On Wednesday, December 21, Deputy M. Peek responded to the complaint of a theft in the 200 block of Spruce Avenue in the Overstreet area. The complainant reported the theft of a water pump.

On Thursday, December 22, Deputy M. Peek conducted a traffic stop on State Road (SR) 71 and Pine Avenue in Wewahitchka. The traffic stop resulted in the arrest of Jason I. Weathers (29) for Possession of Methamphetamine, two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance, and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Weathers was transported to the GCDF.

On Friday, December 23, the GCSO extradited Devin R. Simmons (21) from the Bay County Jail. Simmons had an arrest warrant for Failure to Appear on his original charge of Possession of Less Than Twenty Grams and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. He was transported to the GCDF.

On Saturday, December 24, Deputy B. Smith conducted a traffic stop for an equipment violation on SR 71 and Gary Rowell Road north of Wewahitchka. The stop resulted in the arrest of Wesley A. Southerland (36) for Possession of Less Than Twenty Grams of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia. Southerland was transported to the GCDF.
