GCSO LAW ENFORCEMENT SUMMARY

APRIL 30, 2018 - MAY 6, 2018

On Tuesday May 1st, Gary Allen Roberts (41) was served with an arrest warrant at the Gulf County Detention Facility for Violation of Probation on the original charge of giving false information to law enforcement.

On Tuesday, May 1st, Deputy M. Peek and Deputy S. Sheline conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of Walnut Street and Taylor Street in Wewahitchka. During the stop, Deputy Peek deployed K-9 Brix to conduct a free air sniff around the vehicle. Brix alerted on the vehicle and a probable cause search ensued. Methamphetamine was found inside a purse that belonged to Chrystan Paige Davidson (27). Davidson, who was present in the vehicle, was placed under arrest and charged with Possession of Methamphetamine.

On Wednesday, May 2nd, Investigators S. Ferrell and P. Williams were assisting the Florida Department of Correction Probation and Patrol with a home visit in the 200 block of Whippoorwill Street. Investigators encountered Justin Alan Catrett (30) and Haylee Alyss Johnson (30) at the residence. During the investigation Catrett and Johnson were arrested on drug related charges. Catrett was charged with Possession of Methamphetamine, two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance (Oxycodone & Carisoprodol), Possession of Marijuana, Possession of Drug Paraphernalia and Violation of Probation. Johnson was charged with Possession of Methamphetamine, two counts of Possession of a Controlled Substance (Oxycodone & Carisoprodol), Possession of Marijuana and Possession of Drug Paraphernalia.

On Wednesday, May 2nd, the Gulf County Sheriff's Office received a report of a physical altercation that was developing inside of a vehicle while it was traveling on Hwy 98 between Franklin County and Port St. Joe. After hearing the description of the vehicle given by dispatchers, Deputy House located the vehicle and stopped it on Hwy 98 near 20th Street. Sgt. Williams and Deputy House identified a male and a female inside the vehicle. There was no evidence of a physical altercation but did find evidence of drug use. The driver, Arnold Edward Rutledge (47), was found to be in possession of methamphetamine and a pipe to smoke it with. Rutledge was placed under arrest and charged accordingly.

On Wednesday, May 2nd, Deputy D. Sanders and Deputy G. Desrosier went to the 200 block of East Lake View Drive to execute an arrest warrant on Clyde Dillon McDaniel (20). The warrant for McDaniel was for failing to appear in court. McDaniel was located and taken into custody.

On Thursday, May 3rd, Sgt. J. Williams was dispatched to the Howard Creek Country Mart in reference to a physical disturbance. It was alleged that Randall Lee Chancey (46) attacked a disabled man who was walking with a cane. According to witnesses Chancey, who was unprovoked, took the man's cane from him and hit him with it several times. The victim was transported to a hospital to be treated for his injuries. Chancey was placed under arrest and charged with Abuse of a Disabled Person.

On Friday, May 4th, Darrell Larvon Vann (44) was arrested by Deputy G. Desrosier on Woodmere Drive for a Violation of Probation warrant. Vann was on probation for Possession of Methamphetamine.

On Saturday, May 5th, Deputy M. Peek conducted a traffic stop near the intersection of Hwy 71 and East River Road. The driver of the vehicle was identified as Tyrone Laster (53). During the course of the traffic stop, Laster was placed under arrest and charged with Reckless Driving.

On Saturday, May 5th, Gulf County deputies were dispatched to Highland View in reference to a missing fourteen-year-old female juvenile. A search of the area ensued and the missing juvenile was located. The juvenile was found in the company of a male juvenile, age seventeen. It was revealed that the two were engaged in activities of a sexual nature. After an investigation by Investigator P. Baxley, the seventeen-year-old male was placed under arrest and charged with Lewd and Lascivious Molestation on a child under the age of sixteen and Lewd and Lascivious Battery on a child under the age of sixteen.

On Sunday, May 5th, the Gulf County Sheriff's Office received multiple reports of a reckless driver in the area of Hwy 98 and CR 386. Deputies located the vehicle, still traveling on Hwy 98, and followed it into the Highland View area where Deputy M. Manley conducted a traffic stop on it. The driver, who was later identified as David Eric Hall (49), appeared to be under the influence of alcohol. Deputy Manley had Hall perform some field sobriety assessments and Hall performed poorly on the assessments. Hall was then placed under arrest for suspicion of driving under the influence of alcohol. Hall submitted to a breath rest to determine his blood alcohol content (BAC). Hall's BAC was .241, which is three times the legal limit. Hall was transported to the Gulf County Detention Facility and charged with Driving Under the Influence.
